Lieutenant Colonel Feeley was commissioned as Field Artillery officer in May, 1993. His previous assignments in the active component include Platoon Leader and Battalion Assistant Operations Officer, 6-37th Field Artillery (MLRS), 2d Infantry Division, Republic of Korea; Company Fire Support Officer, Firing Battery Executive Officer and Battalion Fire Direction Officer, 2-15th Field Artillery (M119), 10th Mountain Division, Fort Drum, New York; and Fire Control Officer, 3d Infantry Division Artillery, Fort Stewart, Georgia.

Lieutenant Colonel Feeley joined the New York Army National Guard (NYARNG) in 2000 and Commanded Battery B/1-156th Field Artillery (M119), after serving as the Battalion Fire Support Officer for 1-105th Infantry (Light). Following the September 11, 2001, attacks he served as the Commander of the Security Detachment at La Guardia Airport in New York City and he deployed to Iraq in 2004 as the Battalion Fire Support Officer for Task Force 2-108th Infantry (Light). Upon returning from Iraq in 2005 he served in multiple positions in the Military Naval Operations and Training Directorate of the Joint Force Headquarters, New York National Guard, while simultaneously serving as the Battalion Operations Officer and then the Battalion Executive Officer for the 1-258th FA (M119)(Washington's Grays).

In 2009, Lieutenant Colonel Feeley transitioned to the Army National Guard Directorate of the National Guard Bureau in Washington, D.C. During his tour in Washington, he has served as the Assistant Executive Officer to the Director, Army National Guard, as the Programs and Resources Branch Chief, in the Army National Guard G-1 Personnel Programs, Manpower, and Readiness Division, as well as the Chief, Officer Management Branch, Human Capital Management Division. Lieutenant Colonel Feeley's last assignment in Washington was at Headquarters, Department of the Army, in the Office of the Chief of Staff, Army, General Officer Management Office. Lieutenant Colonel Feeley then returned to New York to command the 1-258th FA from October 2013 to October 2015.

Lieutenant Colonel Feeley is a graduate of the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, the Field Artillery, and Infantry, Captains Career Courses, the Intermediate Level Education and Advanced Operations Warfighter Courses as well as the Human Resources Management Qualification Course (HRMQC). He is a graduate of Geneseo State University, Geneseo, New York, where he majored in History, and he completed a Master of Arts, with a concentration in International Relations, with the University of Oklahoma.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (2), the Army Commendation Medal (4), the Army Achievement Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal, the Korea Service Medal, the Combat Action Badge, the Basic Parachutist Badge and the Army Staff Identification Badge.
