




*U.S. Army Adjutant General's School moves to

U.S. Army Institute of Administration (USAIA) established at Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN consolidating the Army Adjutant General and Finance Schools in Gates-Lord Hall.

HISTORY OF THE U.S. ARMY SOLDIER SUPPORT INSTITUTE

The U.S. Army Administration Center (ADMINCEN), parent organization of the USAIA established as one of three combat and training development integrating centers assigned to the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC). As the focal point for Personnel Service Support (PSS), ADMINCEN integrated into the Army's overall combined arms capability missions related to financial management, human resource management, military justice, religious activities, medical services, public affairs, and foreign language training.

HISTORY OF THE U.S. ARMY SOLDIER SUPPORT INSTITUTE



ADMINCEN and USAIA reorganized into the U.S. Army Soldier Support Center (USASSC) and U.S. Army Institute of Personnel and Resource Management (USAIPRM) to accommodate the Army-wide responsibility for the "human dimension of combat. USAIPRM composed of four schools -- Adjutant General, Finance, Computer Science, and Personnel Management.



Housed in the massive U.S. Army Finance and Accounting Center building at Fort Benjamin Harrison, the U.S. Army Recruiting and Retention School was established as one of five schools composing the U.S. Army Institute of Personnel and Resource Management .

USAIPRM reorganized into the U.S. Army Soldier Support Institute (USASSI) at Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN. By 1984, the Institute had grown to incorporate 8 separate schools – the Adjutant General, Finance, Community Activities, Computer Science, Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC), Recruiting and Retention, School of Music, and the Soldier Physical Fitness Schools.



USASSC Noncommissioned Officers Academy established to provide leadership training for senior enlisted specialists from the PSS mission area. The NCO Academy transferred from Fort Benjamin Harrison to Fort Jackson, SC with other USASSI schools in 1995 and moved into new facilities.

Combined Arms Support Command
Fort Lee, VA**



A reorganization of the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command's combat development community disestablished the USASSC and merged its integrating mission with the Logistics Center at Fort Lee, VA. The resulting organization, the U.S. Army Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM), was established at Fort Lee in October 1990. Under the reorganization, USASSI became part of the new CASCOM, the battlefield integrator for logistics and personnel service support.



The 1991 Base Closure and Realignment Commission nominated Fort Benjamin Harrison for closure and the transfer of USASSI to Fort Jackson, SC. The transfer began officially in October 1994 and was completed September 30, 1995.

**U.S. Army
Sustainment Center of Excellence**



The U.S. Army Sustainment Center of Excellence (SCOE) was established at Fort Lee, VA, as the Army's focal point for Sustainment, one of six principle warfighting functions that contribute to our Army's ability to engage in operations across the full spectrum of possible military conflict. The SCOE represents a further consolidation of CASCOM; the Army Quartermaster, Transportation, and Ordnance Schools; and the U.S. Army Soldier Support Institute.
