Captain Joseph H. Johnson III was born in New Orleans, LA and commissioned a second lieutenant in the Adjutant General Corps following his 2004 graduation from Louisiana State University. After graduating from the Adjutant General Officer Basic Course, CPT Johnson was assigned to 377th Theater Sustainment Command, New Orleans, Louisiana, where he served as the Special Troops Battalion S-1. In 2006, CPT Johnson was assigned to the 3d Armored Cavalry Regiment in Fort Hood, Texas, where he served as the Regimental Adjutant and Deputy Regimental S-1 and later served as the 4th Squadron, 3d ACR (Longknife) S-1. CPT Johnson deployed with 4th Squadron, 3d ACR in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom 07-09. Upon graduation from the Adjutant General Captain's Career Course in 2009, he was assigned as an instructor in the Combined Arms Department. CPT Johnson currently serves as the

Headquarters and Headquarters Company Commander for the Training Support Battalion, United States Army Soldier Support Institute.
