COL Regal L. Perry, born in Greenville, MS, was commissioned as a 2LT in December 1986. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education from The University of Alabama, Tuscaloosa, AL and a Master's of Science in Education from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, MI.

After completing the Adjutant General (AG) Officer Basic Course in 1989, COL Perry served as a Platoon Leader in the 813th Replacement Detachment, Gordo, AL.

In May 1990 COL Perry was assigned as an Assistant Adjutant (AGR) to the 5064th United States Army Garrison (USAG), Detroit, MI. In 1990 the 5064th USAG mobilized to Fort McCoy, WI to provide augmentation for the post's base operations capabilities throughout Operation Desert Storm. In 1994 COL Perry attended the Combined Logistics Officer Advance Course at Fort Lee, VA followed by an Operations Officer assignment with the 521st Maintenance Battalion, Milwaukee, WI.

In 1997 COL Perry was assigned as a Personnel Management Officer at the Army Reserve Personnel Command (AR-PERSCOM), St. Louis, MO. In November 1999 COL Perry was assigned as a Logistics Staff Officer in the Combat Support Coordination Team #2, Tague, South Korea.

In 2001 COL Perry was assigned to the United States Army Reserve Command (USARC), Fort McPherson, GA serving as a Standard Requirements Code Manager (Ordnance/Signal), followed by an assignment with Headquarters Third Army, Fort McPherson, GA. In 2005, 2007, and 2009 COL Perry deployed to Camp Arifan, Kuwait, serving as Personnel Service Support Officer. In 2009 COL Perry served as the Chief Force Management Division at the 377th Theater Sustainment Command, Belle Chasse, LA. In 2012 COL Perry was selected to serve as the Executive Officer for the United States Army Reserve Command, Deputy Commanding General (Operations).

COL Perry's military schooling includes: Airborne, Air Assault, Adjutant General Officer Basic Course, Combined Logistics Officer Advanced Course, Combined Arms and Services Staff School, Command and General Staff Officers Course, and Advanced Joint Professional Military Education Course. Civilian schooling includes: Bachelor of Science, from The University of Alabama, Tuscaloosa, AL, and a Master's of Science in Education from Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, MI.

COL Perry's awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters (OLC), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal with 1 Bronze Star, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary and Service Medals, Korea Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces

Reserve Medal with M Device Numeral 2 and Bronze Hourglass, Army Service Ribbon, and the Army Superior Unit Award. He is also authorized the Airborne Badge, the Air Assault Badge, the Overseas Service Ribbon with numeral 2, and the Reserve Component Overseas Ribbon.
