First Sergeant Fabian A. Murillo is a native of Orlando, Florida. He enlisted in the United States Army in June 1995. He completed Basic Combat Training at Fort Leonard Wood, MO and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, SC where he was awarded the Military Occupation Specialty of 75B, Personnel Administrative Specialist. His Current PMOS is 42A, Human Resources Sergeant.

First Sergeant Murillo is currently assigned as the 1SG of the Advanced Leaders Course (ALC) NCO Academy, Soldier Support Institute (SSI), Fort Jackson, SC. Other duty assignments include; Personnel Specialist for Headquarters and Headquarters Company G1, 2nd ID Korea; Personnel Administrative Specialist for Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment S1, 3rd Personnel Group, Fort Hood Texas; Personnel Administrative Specialist for 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry (Mechanized) 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas; Personnel Services NCO for 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry Regiment, 1st Armor Division, Baumholder, Germany; Strength Management NCOIC for Headquarters, 4th Infantry Division G1, Fort Hood, Texas where he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; Senior Personnel Human Resources NCO for 3rd Battalion, 67th Armor Regiment and deployed once again in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Upon completion of his deployment he PCS'd to Fort Jackson, SC to serve as an ALC SGL and later as a Senior SGL. He has served as the Brigade Senior Human Resources Sergeant for the 45th Sustainment Brigade, 8th TSC in Hawaii where he also deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan. 1SG Murillo's most recent assignment was with the Human Resources Command where he served as the 42A5O Senior Professional Development NCO for the Soldier Support Branch and as the Operations SGM for the Sergeants Major Branch at Fort Knox, Kentucky.
