ALL STUDENTS: The United States Army School of Music (USASOM) is located on Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek - Ft. Story (JEBLC-FS), 1420 Gator Blvd, Virginia Beach, VA on Shore Drive (Rt. 60), off Route 13. Students will arrive at Norfolk International Airport and secure taxi service to the reporting locations listed under each respective course (Approximately \$20 one way). You will be reimbursed for the cost when you file your travel settlement. The USASOM does not provide shuttle service to and from the airport. Prohibited Items: All students should note that firearms, bowie knives or machetes are prohibited items on JEBLC-FS.

ADVANCED INDIVIDUAL TRAINING/BASIC MUSIC COURSE (ACTIVE AND RESERVE COMPONENT)

INSTRUCTIONS:

COVID environment special instructions: All split training option and MOS-T (prior service/reclassification) Soldiers must arrive 14 days prior to the start date of the course to complete a 14-day restriction of movement.

A. REPORTING: During duty hours (0730-1700), report to the AIT Drill Sergeant office located at Scott Hall BEQ, Bldg 3604, and Room B-113. Scott Hall is located at the corner of E and 10th Street. After normal duty hours and weekends before 2100 hours, report to the Officer of the Day (OOD) located at the Quarterdeck / School of Music (BLDG. 3602), D Street, JEBLC-FS, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-2617. (NOTE: If reporting after 2100, report to the OOD at Scott Hall / BLDG. 3604-D). Drill sergeant duty cell is (757) 272-4485; OOD duty cell is (401) 374-0529; and 1SG duty cell is (757) 748-5072.

- B. Students reporting for AIT must reside in the barracks. Movement of family members or household goods to the training location is not permitted.
- C. AIT Soldiers must bring their complete clothing bag issue with them to school. Any missing clothing items required for training may be the students' responsibility to replace. Appropriate civilian clothing may be authorized for wear during non-duty hours once student has earned the appropriate phase level.
- D. Split Training Option Soldiers may drive a POV to the school, but will not be authorized to drive for the remainder of the course. The POV must have a valid state registration and current insurance.

E. PRIOR SERVICE SOLDIERS:

Prior service (PS) Soldiers attending the Basic Music Course for MOS reclassification may drive a POV to the school, and are authorized to operate the POV outside of normal duty hours. Soldiers will be housed in the barracks. Linens and pillows are provided, but Soldiers may bring their own. Refrigerators and microwaves are furnished in each barracks room.

Soldiers are authorized the government meal rate on TDY orders. Government meals are available at the Gator Inn/Torgerson Galley three meals a day, seven days a week. Soldiers will not be issued a meal card.

MOS-T Soldiers should bring all clothing bag items, but no inventory will take place. At a minimum, Soldiers must bring complete APFU with accessories; ACU with at least two pairs of boots; Army Service Uniform with all accessories and accoutrement. Students should not bring TA-50, as it will be issued after arrival to the school. Civilian clothing is authorized after duty hours and weekends (when not engaged in training). Self-service laundry facilities are available in the barracks free of charge; however, students must purchase their own detergent.
